<i>Medium</i>	Downloadable from the web, adaptable, meant to be applied to qualitative data such as reflective writing assignments, online dialogue, transcribed interviews, and open-ended survey questions	Web-based mixed methods survey (multiple choice and open-ended questions)	Web-based quantitative	Web-based mixed methods survey (multiple choice and open-ended questions)	Web-based quantitative	Downloadable from the web, printable for paper-based self-assessment.
