

Introduction:

This activity will challenge you to develop an attitude of intercultural openness by initiating and developing relationships with people who are culturally different from you. You will sit down with another person who comes from a different country (and who ideally speaks a different first language) and exchange answers to a list of 25 questions.

Background and Information:

This activity was originally developed by Purdue University's Center for Instructional Excellence (CIE) as a digital badge for the "Purdue University's Passport to Intercultural Learning" (PUPIL) program.
