### Introduction:

You will be assigned to (or choose) a country and asked to have a conversation with someone from that country. The intent is to encourage you to learn more about another part of the world (i.e., government, religion, economy, sports and exercise, language(s) and ethnic group(s), holidays, music, and the arts).

### **Interview Instructions and Handout:**
