You are in a car that's moving at a constant speed

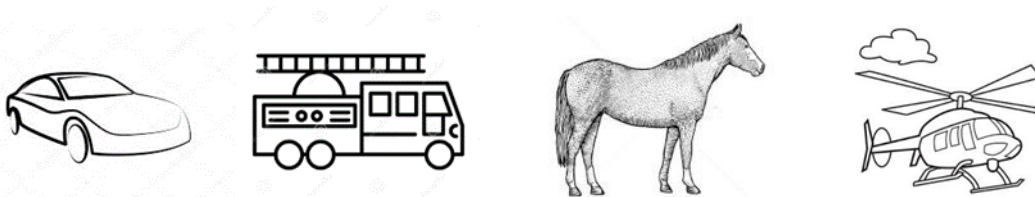
To your left is a steep downward slope. To your right, a large fire truck moves at the same speed as your car.
