



## **Introduction:**

Real-time word cloud builders can be used to generate discussion surrounding intercultural learning concepts. This activity will encourage you to talk about intercultural learning concepts in both face-to-face and virtual environments through word clouds. These word clouds will demonstrate themes/patterns as you reflect on the concept, as well as the concept's complexity.

## **Participant Instructions:**

1. The facilitator will send you a link to a word cloud and instruct you to start typing in words you associate with the central discussion concept (shared by your facilitator). Keep in mind that there will be a time limit to generate words.
2. Once the word cloud is finished generating, debrief with the following questions:
  - What themes and patterns do you notice across the words that have been generated?
  - Which words on here surprised you? Why?
  - Which words are the largest? Why do you think those words were the most common?
  - Which words are smaller? Why do you think those words were less common, but still a part of the picture?
  - What does this word cloud tell us about the complexity of this concept?
